

Report from the Village Hall Trustees to Annual Parishes Meeting 13th May 2025

At the AGM in December 2024, Stephen Rackham was thanked for his many years of dedicated service as he stepped down as Treasurer of the Village Hall. Not only has he maintained the books, but he has overseen – and carried out much of – the maintenance of the Hall itself. He continues as a Trustee.

The Trustees were pleased to elect Amanda Mann as a Trustee and as Treasurer.

Although the profit was down approximately £1500 compared to the previous financial year, we have been able to meet the near doubling in electricity costs and carry out some essential renovation. The income was boosted by donations totalling £966 and from Hall Hire as part of the Warm Room scheme funded by Central Government in the winter and as a Community Hub in the summer.

There has been no increase in hall hire fees this year.

A new cleaner started in the Spring and seems to be doing a good job.

At the AGM of the Village Hall held in December 2024 the film of Levington made in 2008 for the Village of the Year competition was shown, before sparkling wine and canapes were enjoyed. It was apparent to all present just how much work the Parish Council of 2008 had put in to making the entry so successful.
