4-yr Plan - update

Parish Council Meeting 3rd March 2025

The 4-yr Plan was adopted by the PC in January 24, created from a survey of residents in October 2023. It is intended to provide the PC with a mandate to consider items identified by residents in a collective consultation. They are items to consider secondary to the core responsibilities of the PC.

The Plan has 7 items included.

1. I suggest the following two items can be closed as completed:

- Dog waste
- Management of Church Field

Proposal 1: Items dog waste and management of Church Field are recorded as completed and closed.

2. The following 3 items are currently open:

- Emergency plan
- Website
- Flooding

Proposal 2: Items Emergency plan, Website, and Flooding are discussed to consider whether they should remain open, and if so, identify next steps and allocation of lead cllr.

3. There are 2 items that are currently awaiting consideration:

- Speeding – Cllrs to note the change of position of Suffolk Police in relation to enforcement of 20mph speed limits (Nov 22 Report to PC attached FYI, to provide context).
- ANPR camera – Cllrs to note the public concern and wish for cameras at the end of 2024 when a) a police chase came through the village and b) when street racers have entered the village from their meet on Felixstowe Rd.

4. Having taken a view on the presently open items, Cllrs should consider whether capacity exists at this point to open one of the awaiting 2 items, and if so, which one.

Proposal 3: Cllrs consider whether there is capacity to open one of the awaiting items for consideration.
